Dr. hab. Claire Balandier is professor of ancient history at the University of Avignon and the head of the French archaeological mission at Paphos that she created in 2008 under the auspices of the Department of Antiquities of Cyprus and of the French Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs. As an historian and archaeologist, she specialized in the study of defensive policies of ancient Greek cities, which she subsequently extended onto the Ptolemaic and later periods of history, including the area of the Levant (Syro-Palestine). She also supervised the PhD dissertation of Yannick Vernet on "The Apollo of Cyprus" and co-edited the Festschrift in honour of Jacqueline Karageorghis about religion and cults in Cyprus.
